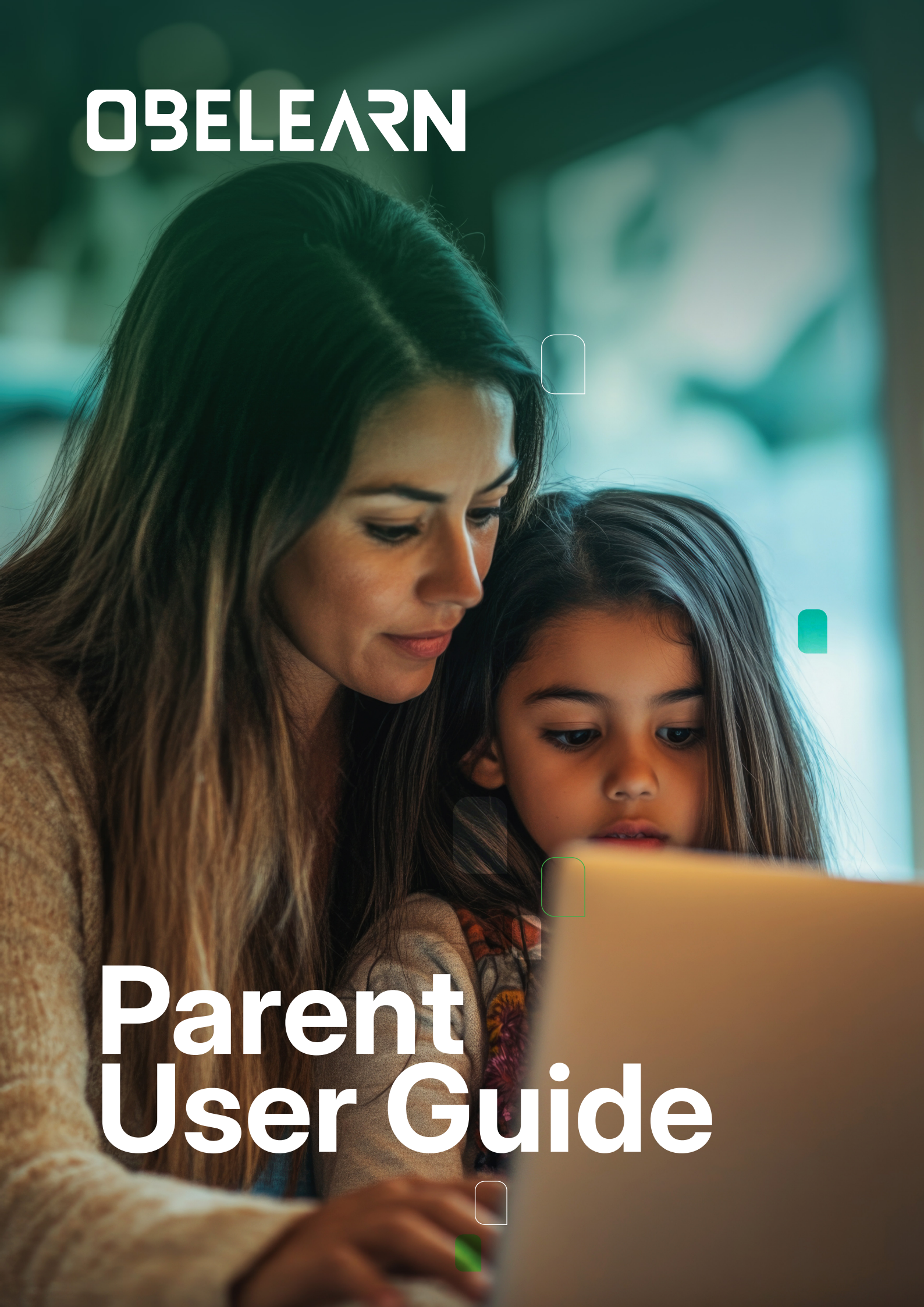

This guide explains how you can support your child in accessing and using the platform effectively.

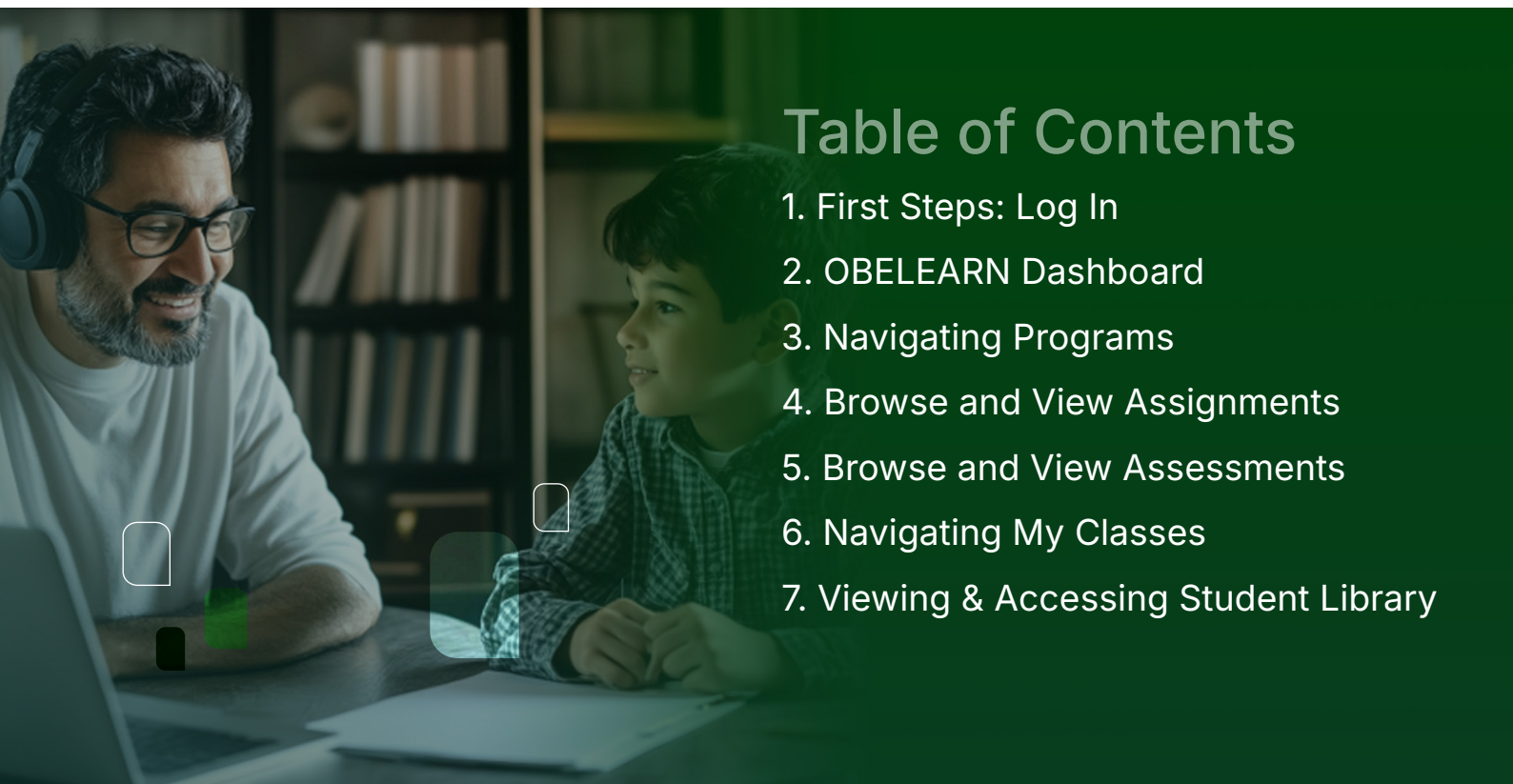


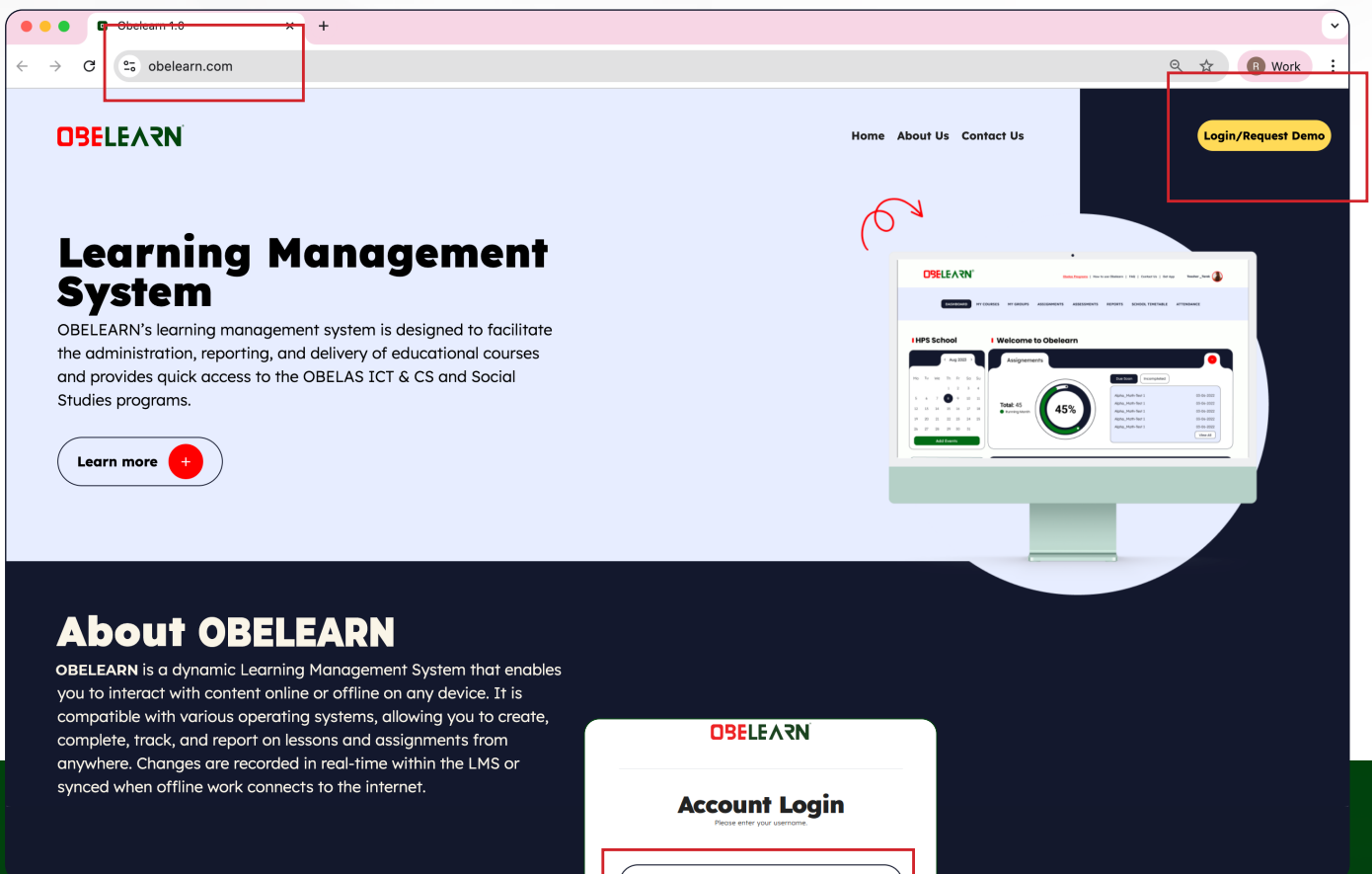

First Steps: Log In

1. Go to <https://www.obelearn.com/>.
2. Click on Login / Request Demo.



3. Enter the username provided by your school and click Continue. Then, enter the password on the next screen and click Login Now.

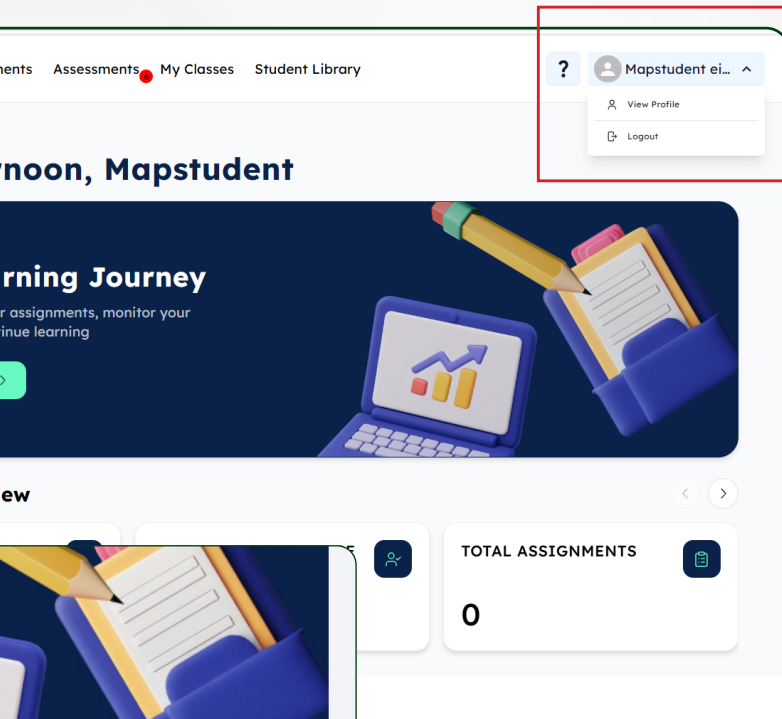

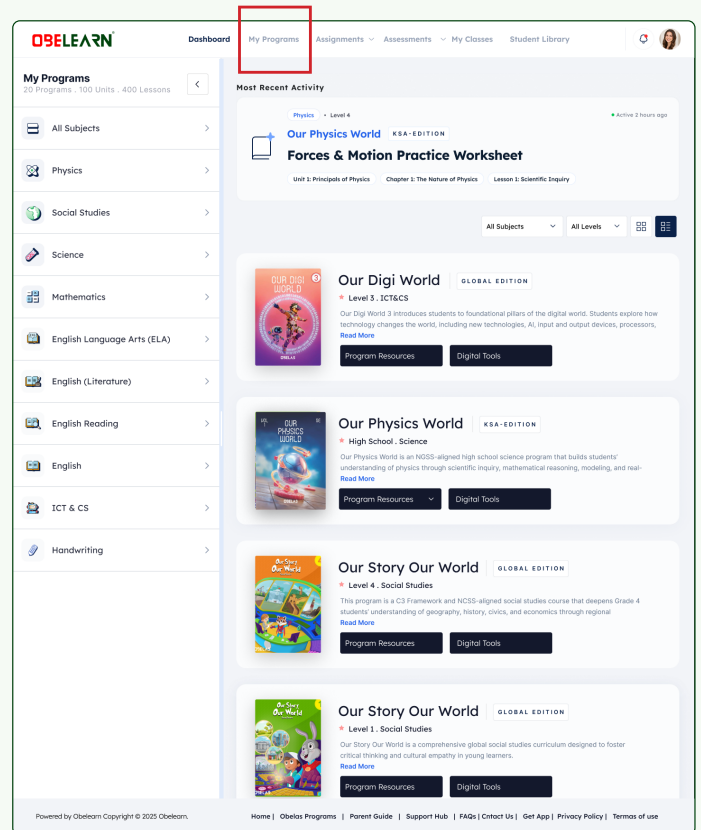

Navigating Programs

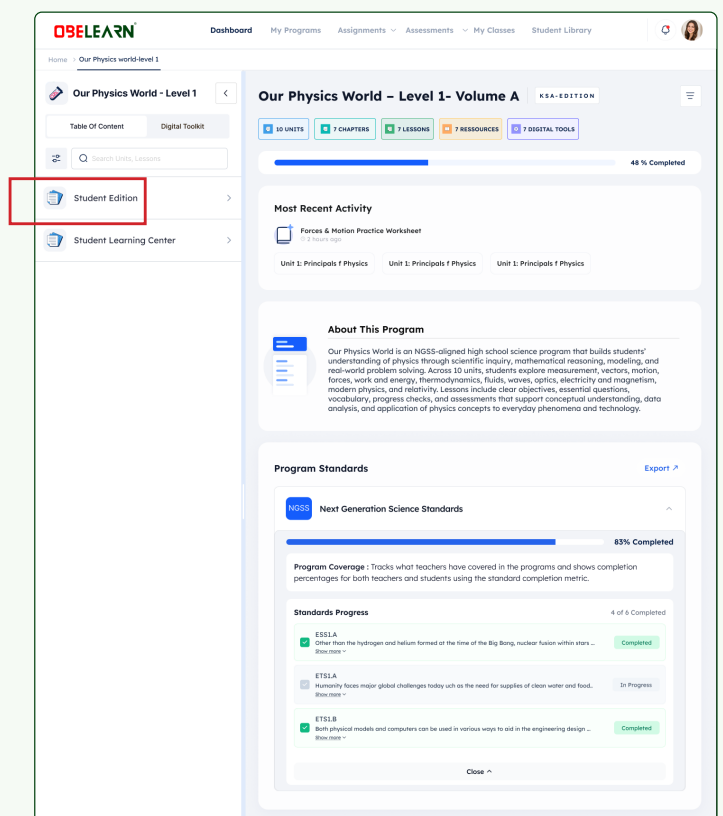
Your child can access their assigned programs by clicking **My Programs** from the top navigation menu.

From here, they can:

- View all programs assigned to them.
- See their most recently opened resource at the top of the page.
- Filter programs by Subject and Level.
- Use the subject list in the left panel to quickly view programs for a specific subject.
- Switch between the available program card layouts to change how programs are displayed.
- To open the program resources, such as the Student Book, Workbook, and other available resources, click Program Resources on the corresponding program card.



- Open Program Resources to browse the available resources using the Table of Contents. Your child can expand the units, chapters, and lessons in the left panel, then select a resource to open and view it.

 - Your child's progress against learning standards.

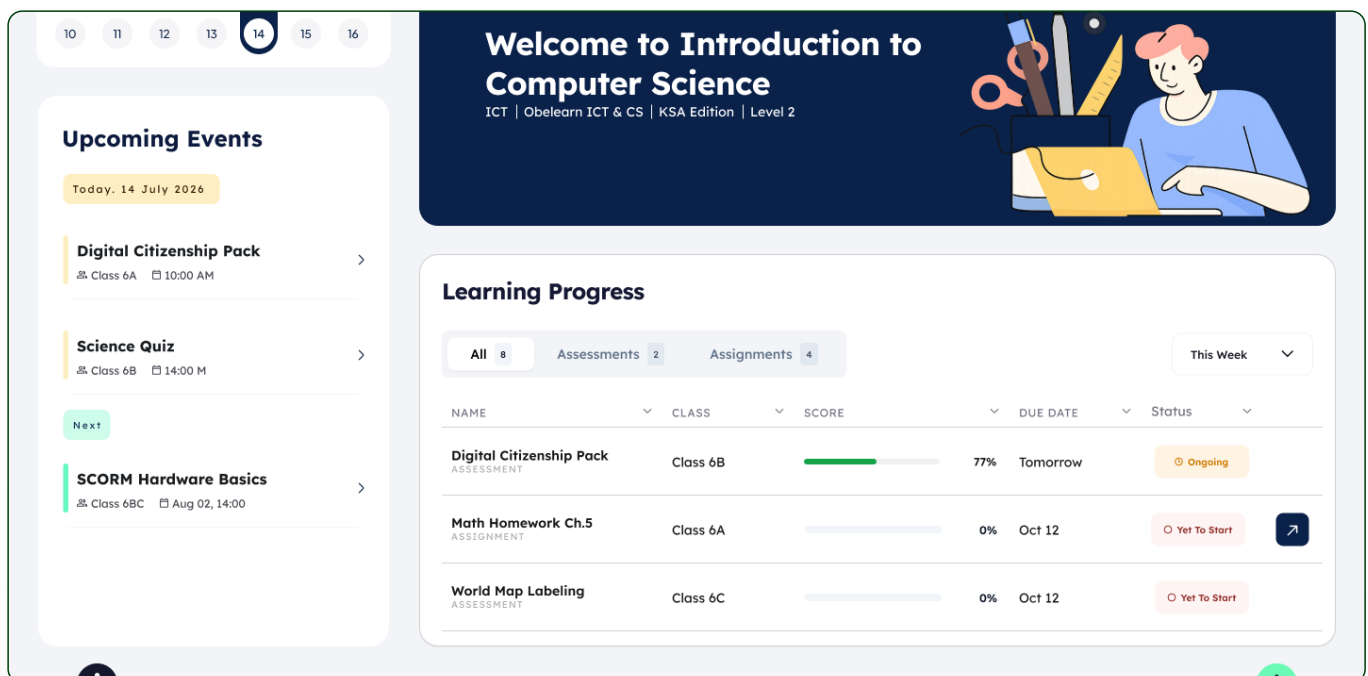
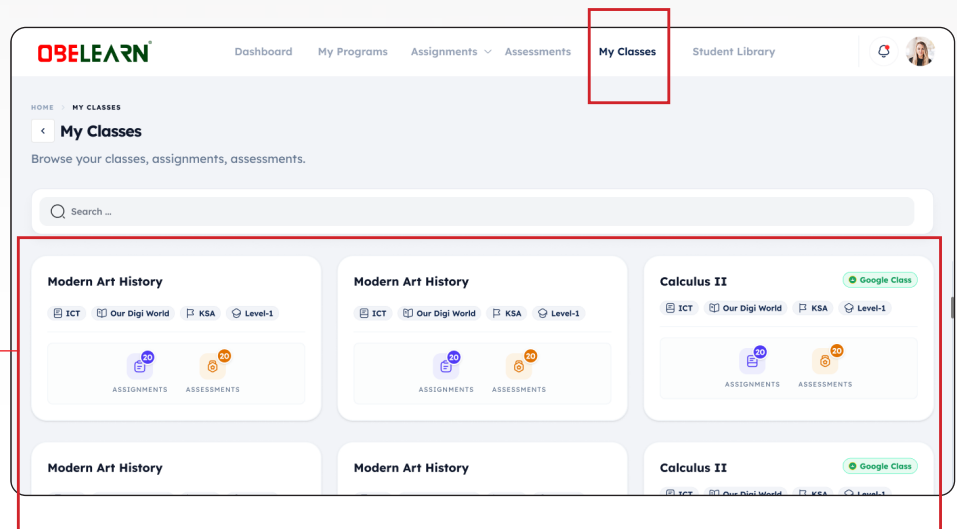

- A list of classes will be displayed, along with the assigned course and grade for each class.



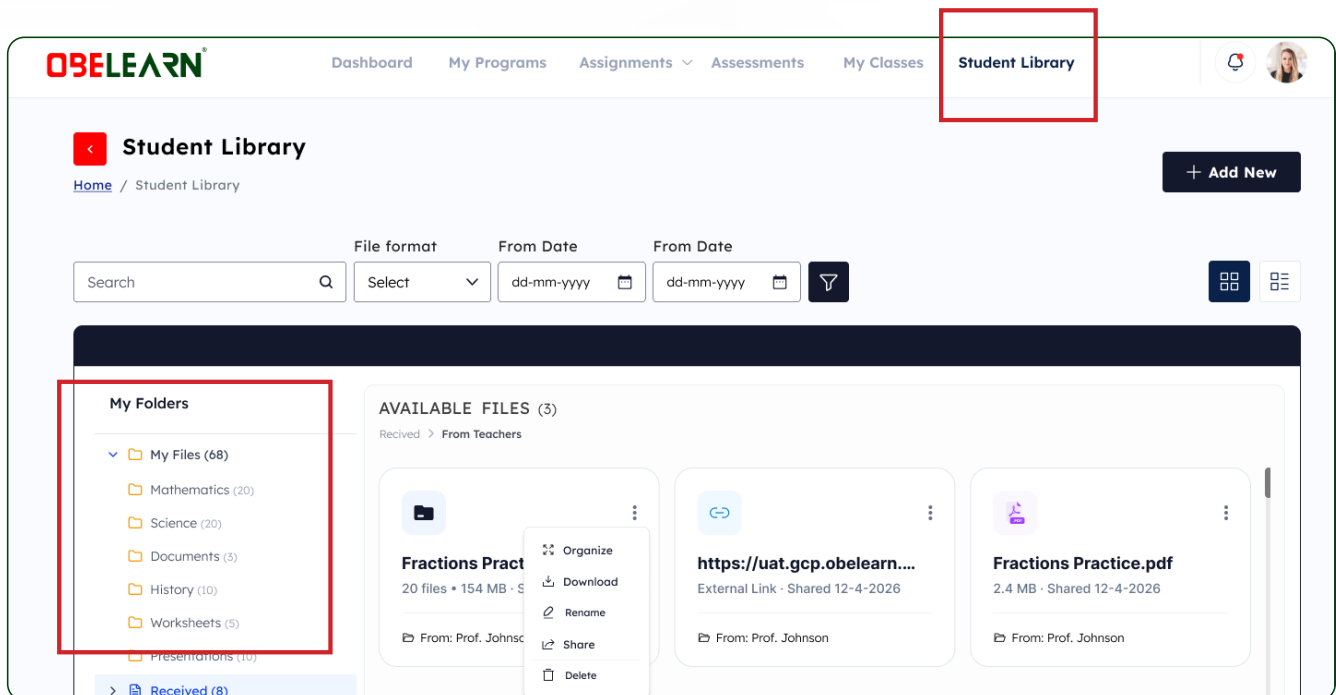
- Clicking on a class will open the Class Dashboard, where your child can see:

Viewing & Accessing Student Library

The **Student Library** is a centralized area where your child can store and organize files related to their programs.

- Your child can upload and save files to their Student Library.
- They can organize files into folders and subfolders to keep their learning materials structured and easy to find.
- They can open or download files from the Student Library whenever needed.



In addition, students can:

- Share files or folders with their teachers directly from the Student Library.
- View files and folders shared with them by their teachers under the Received folder.
